



CZECH UNIVERSITY OF LIFE SCIENCES PRAGUE TO TAKE PART IN A NEW EIT-FUNDED PROJECT FOR BOOSTING INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Czech University of Life Sciences Prague is happy to announce that it will be taking part in a new project called HIVE - HEI Innovation for Knowledge Intensive Entrepreneurship. The project aims to increase the innovation and entrepreneurial capacity of project partners by networking and exchanging the best practices identified nationally and internationally. The project aims to scale up commercialisation and introduce institutional change in higher education through the implementation of a jointly developed Innovation Vision Action Plan with a view towards 2030.

The project will receive funding from the [EIT HEI Initiative: Innovation Capacity Building for Higher Education](#). This initiative of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) aims to boost the entrepreneurial and innovation capacity of higher education institutions (HEIs) across Europe.

Under the EIT HEI Initiative, the project will receive funding of € 1 200 000, and it will run until June 2024.
