

Dean's Regulation no. 9/2022

The fees for study undertaken in the English language for the academic year 2023/2024

Pursuant to Section 58(5) of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions, and in compliance with Internal Regulations in CZU Prague, the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences, CZU Prague, determines the amount of the tuition fees for programmes provided in foreign languages for the academic year 2023/2024.

Under Section 58(5) of the Act, tuition fees for programmes in foreign languages for the individual study programmes are as follows:

Tuition fees for study programmes undertaken in a foreign language apply to each commenced year of study and are payable by 31/8/2023 for newly admitted students or prior to enrollment in higher years. The fee is set and is valid only for the academic year 2023/2024. The tuition fee may change in the next academic year, according to the Faculty of Environmental Sciences Dean's Regulation.



The fee is paid according to the faculty's instructions and is considered paid on the day the fee is credited to the CZU bank account or by deposit at the CZU cash desk. After the enrollment, the fee cannot be refunded.
