



CZU Halls of Residence in Prague

Halls of residence can be found right on the university campus.

The buildings are named A-J, as they were built in the past.

You can get accommodated here in twin rooms with a separate bathroom or a shared bathroom for two rooms. The other rooms are twins or quadruples; the facilities for these rooms are in the

Wi-Fi is available in all halls of residence. Access to the building all day is only available to students in residence with their ISIC card. All rooms are equipped with simple furniture, bedding, and a small refrigerator in each room. In some halls you can cook in your room, in others there are communal kitchens in the corridor.

It is necessary to apply for accommodation electronically via the portal ISKAM.CZU.CZ

All important information, including the price list, can be found at www.kam.czu.cz.

Other matters related to accommodation are handled by the Accommodation Office in Hall of Residence B or the Head of the respective hall or the receptionist.

You can borrow a key for a washing machine, dryer, ironing board, iron, vacuum cleaner, etc. at the reception.

You can also report any technical faults in your room there. All reception desks are open 24 hours a day, except for the reception desk in Hall of residence A, which has limited opening hours 6-10am, 2-10pm.



Hall of Residence A

The smallest capacity and therefore the quietest hall, so if you're a night owl, prefer another hall. A has 112 beds for students in 2+2 apartments with shared bathroom facilities. The apartments are equipped with basic furniture, bedding and a fridge. As an added bonus, there are lockers in the corridors of Hall A, which you can use for free as additional storage space. The kitchens are shared on the floor and include a microwave oven, an oven, an electric four-burner stove and a kettle. You must bring your own cooking utensils. There is also a GreenGood composter and a Reuse Point. You can enjoy free use of the gym, lounge with Relax Zone and bike room. There is also a large selection of board games available for rent at the reception, which is open 6:00-10:00 and 14:00-22:00. You can also rent a vacuum cleaner, ironing board, iron or hairdryer at the reception. Of course, there is a laundry room with drying facilities, including a tumble dryer.

Hall of Residence BCD

The largest, busiest hall with a capacity of 388 rooms (14 quadruple, the rest twin with separate accessories in the room or shared in the corridor).

The common kitchenettes in the corridors are equipped with an electric cooker and a microwave oven.

At the reception, which is open 24 hours a day, you can borrow keys for the common rooms, kitchenette with a hot air oven, washing machines, tumble dryers, bike room, etc. You can also borrow some daily necessities (iron, vacuum cleaner, etc.) On the ground floor of the BCD hall, there is the Halls of Residence Library, where you can borrow a selection of world fiction and popular nonfiction. The University-wide centre operates a so-called FREE SHOP in the building, where you can give new life to old things and thus serve someone else. You can play table tennis on the first and second

Nowadays, a club has been created in the basement of the B hall, which serves as a music rehearsal room, but mainly as a room for concerts, meetings, etc.

There is also a new video room with a projector, storage boxes, and other projects coming soon.

In Hall BCD you will be taken care of by Alena Pyšvejcová, the head of the hall, and by Růžena Mandáková, the manager.



Hall of Residence EFG


