Project proposal – evaluation report



- **Excellence** lack of detailed description of the Key Performance Indicators
- Impact the proposal does not adequately address potential barriers/obstacles that might negatively affect the realization of the expected impacts
- ❖ Impact aspects such as data protection and Intellectual Property Rights management are inadequately considered.
- ❖ Implementation risk management addresses some risks to the project. However, mitigation measures are not sufficiently addressed

Useful tips



First become a partner in consortium with more experienced partners

A small consortium (3-4 institutions) in your first leading position

Build a consortium with institutions you have a previous experience with

Make sure that all project partners cooperate right from the beginning Be realistic in your setting project goals / deliverables / indicators

Efficient tandem between Project manager & Project Investigator
