
### RELOCATION OF THE CZU WELCOME CENTRE

### PRACTICAL INFORMATION

# THE UNIVERSITY ELECTRONIC WALLET (UEP) PAYMENT FUNCTION HAS BEEN TERMINATED

The card will continue to be used to enter buildings, access printers, and prove employee status at CZU. It is possible to pay for meals in the university canteen, buffets, and restaurants with a meal voucher card, cash, or personal payment cards.

### FREE ACCESS TO THE LABOUR MARKET

On July 1st 2024, a government regulation came into force, which introduces free access to the Czech labour market for citizens of the following nine countries: Australia, Japan, Canada, Republic of Korea, New Zealand, United Kingdom, United States of America, Israel. Citizens of these countries are not required to obtain any kind of employment permit (i.e., work permit, dual

employee card, intra-corporate transfer card, blue card) to be employed in the Czech Republic.

**ATTENTION!** Free access to the labour market does not provide foreigners with the right to reside in the territory of the Czech Republic. It is still necessary to apply for a residence permit according to standard procedures.

### CHANGE OF THE DRIVING LICENCE IN CZECHIA

A foreigner can exchange their valid foreign driving licence for a Czech driving licence if they intend to stay here for more than 6 months. Also, **you can only exchange your foreign driving licence for a Czech one if your current one complies with the requirements**. Otherwise, you will have to take driving lessons and pass the exams in order to apply for a Czech driving licence.

### **REPORTING CHANGES**

### **EU Citizens**

You or your family member are required to report any changes in travel and personal documents, loss or theft of travel/personal documents or residence permit to the Foreign Police.

You must report a change of a travel document within **15 working days** of the new document being issued.

#### **Non-EU Citizens**

You or your family member are required to report any changes in travel and personal documents, loss or theft of travel/personal documents or residence permit to the Foreign Police.

You must report a change of a travel document within **3 working days**. Report the change only after it has taken place.
