

2nd International Garden Party. Both events brought together international scholars and their families.



IMPORTANT UPDATES FOR ALL RESEARCHERS

We would like to share some important reminders and updates regarding residency permits, work permissions, and other key topics for researchers.

1. Residency Permits & Work Permissions

- All inquiries related to residency permits should be directed to Mirka Perst, J.D. at perst@rektorat.czu.
- Check the validity of your passport and residency cards to ensure they are up to date.
- If you are planning to end your employment contract,
 please contact Mirka Perst, J.D. at perst@rektorat.czu in advance.
- In case you are planning to leave Czechia, please check this checklist for departure and contact us in case you need assitance.

2. Work Permissions for Researchers

 Please note that researchers working on scientific research do not have permission to work outside of CZU, except in the case of working in other 90 approved research institutions within the Czech Republic.

3. Health Insurance for Family Members

- For those with family members (children, spouse) in the
 Czech Republic, please make sure to review the
 information regarding health insurance coverage.
- For more details, visit the websites of <u>PVZP</u> and <u>Vitalitas</u>.
 As we are part of EURAXESS, you can get 20% discount on Vitalitas

4. Important Update on Payments at the Ministry of the Interior

- Starting from January 1st, 2025, it is no longer possible to pay at the Ministry of the Interior using stamps (kolek).
- If you need more information or guidance, please contact Mirka Perst, J.D. at perst@rektorat.czu.

5. Annual Taxes Declaration 2025

- If you have only one taxable income (CZU), the university
 will handle your tax reconciliation. Please check the
 Intranet and your email inbox for further instructions.
- oldeclare your taxes independently (until 1st April by paper, until 2nd May eletronically via data mailbox, until 1st July with a tax advisor). We recommend hiring a tax advisor in such cases. A list of advisors: https://www.kdpcr.cz/seznam-danovych-poradcu.
- If you need proof of Czech tax residency (Tax Domicile),

WE ARE PART OF THE EUROPEAN NETWORK EURAXESS

The Czech University of Life Sciences is part of the European network EURAXESS – Researchers in motion, and has thus been included among 600 service centers operating in 42 European countries. The EURAXESS organization was founded by the European Commission to support the mobility of scientific researchers and at the same time to strengthen scientific cooperation between Europe and the world. The CZU EURAXESS Service Center operates at the Welcome Center for International Scholars and offers a range of comprehensive services to scientists and their families moving to the Czech Republic. For example, it provides them with help and assistance from the initial preparatory stages in their 9 home countries to their arrival in a new

environment in the Czech Republic. It helps to find suitable accommodation, assists in processing visas, work permits and offers assistance in solving problems associated with staying abroad. Researchers and their families have access to the national center EURAXESS Czech Republic, where they have the opportunity to get a lot of practical information related to, among other things, professional development, employment and funding. CZU is now part of the national center EURAXESS Czech Republic, which actively cooperates with the European Commission as a support platform for organizations and research centers.
