Rector's regulation No. 2/2019

Award rules Rector's Awards for publication output of CZU employees listed in the Nature index

Article 1 Introductory Provisions

- (1) This directive applies to the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter referred to as the "CZU") and defines the rules for awarding the Rector's Prize for the best publication output of the CZU employees included in the Nature Index (hereinafter referred to as the "Rector's Prize").
- (2) The Rector's Award is awarded in the framework of a competition (hereinafter referred to as "competition" or "announced competition"), which is announced annually by the Rector within the information systems of the CZU in the form of information or news (hereinafter referred to as "Rector's information").
- (3) The competition is generally announced in the first half of the calendar year following the year for which the competition is announced.

Article 2

Registration and terms

- (1) The competition is open to CZU employees and their teams with a scientific publication or a popularisation or applied publication that was published in the year for which the competition is announced, according to the rules specified in Article 3 of this directive.
- (2) The award is granted to employees or students of the CZU (if they are members of a collective) by the Rector of the CZU on the basis of a nomination through the Science and Research Office of the Rectorate of the CZU. No reward is paid to authors who are not employees or students of CZU.
- (3) The announcement of the awarded works will take place in the nearest term of the ceremonial meeting of the Scientific Council of the CZU.



Article 3

Competition rules

- (1) The prize is awarded for publications that are listed in the Nature index for the year for which the competition is announced.
- (2) The maximum amount of the remuneration is CZK 300,000.00, whereby the individual authors meeting the conditions set out in paragraph 2 of this Article shall be entitled to a share of the remuneration according to their ranking in the authors' collective as follows:

1 author 100%

2 authors 1st author 60 %, 2nd author 40 %

3 authors 1st author 50 %, 2nd author 30 %, 3rd author 20 %

4 authors 1st author 40%, 2nd author 30%, 3rd author 20%, 4th author 10%

More than 4 authors 1st author 40%, 2nd author 30%, 3rd author 20%, 4th author 10%,

any other authors 10%

Article 4

Awarding the winners

- (1) Authors and author collectives whose publications will be awarded will be invited in writing to attend the Prize reception.
- (2) The financial reward shall be paid on the dates and in the form that will be communicated to the Rector's Award recipients.

Article 5

Final Provisions

- (1) This directive shall enter into force and effect on the date of its promulgation.
- (2) This directive repeals the Regulation No. 1/2013.
