TRIP TO THE CZECH YELLOWSTONE PARK AND RELIQUARY OF ST. MAURUS AT BEČOV NAD TEPLOU CASTLE

Join us for a scenic and cultural day out, ideal for all ages! **SOOS Nature Reserve**, nicknamed the Czech Yellowstone Park, is known for its unique geological formations. This 221-hectare area of the historic Soos Forest was declared a National Nature Reserve in 1964. It features vast peat bogs and wetlands, where so-called mofettas—also known as mud volcanoes—release large amounts of mineral springs and pure carbon dioxide. A true European rarity, the diatomite shield, remains as a remnant of a long-dried mineral lake.

We will **walk along a 1.2 km educational trail** that leads across the lakebed, explore the peaceful conservation area, and **visit the on-site nature museum** to learn more about the area's rich natural and geological history.

We will also stop in **Bečov nad Teplou Castle** for the tour of this stunning castle and a visit to the exquisite **St. Maurus Reliquary**, a true jewel of the Czech Republic.

VISA ALERT!

Please note – when visiting the office of Ministry of Interior, always remember to bring

- **Passport**
- **Residence permit card**
- **Original or certified copy of your accommodation contract or Confirmation of Accommodation**

TV & RADIO LICENCE FEES

As of **May 2025**, all households in Czechia with **internet access** must pay public broadcasting license fees:

- **Czech TV:** CZK 150/month
- **Czech Radio:** CZK 55/month

Who pays?

Foreign residents with **long-term or permanent residence permits** must register and pay. **Please check with your landlord whether the fee has been paid.**

You may pay online at the official Czech Television (ČT) website, or alternatively pay by filling out a form and sending it via post (or electronically).
