Dear Erasmus Partners,

On January 2012, the Université de Lorraine was created from the merger of the 4 historical Universities in the Region of Lorraine: Université Henri Poincaré Nancy 1 (UHP), Université Nancy 2, Université Paul Verlaine-Metz (UPVM) and Institut National Polytechnique de Lorraine (INPL).

This historical change involves a major administrative restructuring and the Department of European and International Relations (DRIE) presently knows deep changes: the staff and the missions won't necessarily be the same you have known before. All the agreements of the 4 former Universities are now linked with the unique Université de Lorraine.

Of course we definitely look forward to pursue and develop the bilateral agreements that have been signed through the 4 former Universities and we inform you that the Université de Lorraine is now registered as an entire partner within the Erasmus program.
