What are the entry requirements to study at degree level in IT Tralee?

- a. You should be selected by your home institution
- b. You should have a good command of English (TOEIC 750, TOEFL 550, IELTS 5.5) or statement from your English language teacher.

How do I apply?

by completing "Non fulltime Programmes only": Erasmus Application Form: Business Studies (Spring/Autumn Semesters)

When completing this form you will be asked to enter your subject choice. These are Business subjects only. You will be able to select subjects from other disciplines when you arrive in Tralee.

Can I change subjects later?

Yes, when you arrive in Tralee you can "shop" for the first two weeks and then confirm your subject choice.

When should I apply?

You can apply immediately. The latest date is 30 May 2008 for the Autumn Semester and 14 November 2007 for the Spring Semester.

What happens after I apply?

You will receive a confirmation message by email. Later you will receive more information by email.

What are the start dates?

Orientation for Autumn semester international students is Friday 19th September 2008, 11 am, International Office, T111, North Campus.

Where is the Institute of Technology situated?

The North Campus (Business, Tourism, Computing) is about 2 km from the town centre. There is a bus service. The South Campus (Engineering, Science) is situated about 1 km from the town centre.

What about transport in and around Tralee?

There is a bus service from both campuses into the centre of the town and to the main student accommodation complexes. Many students buy a bike to travel to the Institute and to discover the region. In the past some students have brought their car from home and have found that to be of great use – please make sure your car insurance is in order if you do bring your car with you.

What activities can I do in Tralee and the region?

County Kerry of which Tralee is the capital town has beautiful scenery consisting of beaches, mountains, lakes and forests.

Can I take an English language course?

While IT Tralee does provide English language classes as an accredited subject, it does not prepare students for external exams such as TOEFL or IELTS. There are private schools which offer language courses in Tralee.
