INFORMATION SHEET FOR LLP - ERASMUS INCOMING STUDENTS

Application process

Erasmus students apply directly at the International Relations Office of the University of Padova. For the application you need the following documents:

- application form (see below instructions)
- copy of your transcript of records
- learning agreement
- a photocopy of your Identity Card (valid for your whole Erasmus mobility period)
- a photocopy of your Insurance card (valid for your whole Erasmus mobility period)
- A certificate printed and signed by your International Office attesting that you are an Erasmus student
