## **Application**

- 1. Please begin by registering online
- Print out the Application Form, sign it and add a passport photo.
   Then, send it together with the Transcript of Records and the Learning Agreement to:

## **Health Isurance**

- Please give some thought to your health insurance. Without a health insurance policy, we will NOT be able to register you.
- As proof of your health insurance cover, you will need to present the following documents, which you can apply for from the health insurance provider in your home country:
  - → EU countries: E 104 Form
  - → Turkey: AT 11 Form
- If you cannot present this document, you can also choose to take out a German health insurance policy.
