APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Once the nomination is received the Incoming Officer will contact the student directly with all relevant information and instructions on how to fill out the on-line application and what documents are to be provided before arrival:

- Copy of your legal ID card or passport
- Copy of your European Health Insurance Card (only for EU citizens) and/or private insurance
- Sending Institution's statement of participation in the mobility to UD
- Certificate of Enrollment at your Home University for the 2012-13 academic year indicating: the field, the level and the year of studies
- Passport-sized photograph with white background saved as jpg file named with your name and surname
- Provisional Learning Agreement signed by your Home University coordinators

COURSE RESTRICTIONS/REQUIREMENTS

Students have to register for at least 30 ECTS credits per semester

ACADEMIC YEAR DATES FOR 2012-2013

Fall semester begins: September 6th and ends January 18th (ordinary exams included)

Extraordinary exams for the 1st semester begin January 31st and end February 13th

Spring semester begins: February 11th and ends June 12th (ordinary exams included)

Extraordinary exams for the 2nd semester begin June 24th and end July 8th

Yes, but the highest percentage of the credits for each semester MUST belong to the faculty/department the student comes nominated for (usually 3 out of 5 courses)

SPANISH COURSES DATES**Fall semester**

Intensive course (5 ECTS): placement test August 27th

Course begins August 28th and ends September 6th (September 1st included)

Schedule: Monday-Saturday -> 9:00-14:00 everyday

Regular course (6 ECTS): placement test September 6th, 14:30

Course begins September 10th and ends December 20th

Spring semester

Intensive course (5 ECTS): placement test January 8th

Course begins January 10th and ends January 30th

Regular course (6 ECTS): placement test February 11th

Course begins February 13th and ends May 30th

Whole year students are welcome to take the first intensive Spanish course and both regular courses (Fall and Spring). Even if they do not take the fall intensive Spanish, they will NOT be allowed to take the Spring intensive one.

One semester students are welcome to take the intensive Spanish course at the beginning of the semester and the regular one.
