APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Once the nomination is received the Incoming Officer will contact the student directly with all relevant information and instructions on how to fill out the on-line UD form and what documents are to be provided before arrival:

- Copy of legal ID card or passport
- Copy of European Health Insurance Card (only for EU citizens) and/or private medical and accident insurance
- Sending Institution's statement of participation in the mobility to UD
- Proof/Certificate/Confirmation of Enrollment at Home University for period of the mobility indicating: field, level and year of studies
- Passport-sized photograph with white background saved as jpg file named with student's name and surname
- Provisional Learning Agreement signed by student and Home University coordinators

COURSE RESTRICTIONS/REQUIREMENTS

Students have to ordinarily register for at least 30 ECTS credits per semester

ACADEMIC YEAR DATES FOR 2013-2014 (TENTATIVE)

Fall semester: September 4th, 2014 - January 16th, 2015

Re-sit exams for the fall semester: January 26th, 2015 – February 6th, 2014

Spring semester: February 9th, 2015 - June 12th, 2015

Re-sit exams for the spring semester: June 22nd, 2015 – July 3rd, 2015

Compulsory Orientation Days three days before the semester begins

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students should have at least a B1 level either in Spanish or English. It is strongly advised that, if the student does not speak any Spanish, s/he should at least take the Intensive Spanish Course we offer before the semester begins.
