APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Once the nomination is received the Incoming Area Coordinator will confirm it if appropriate and, in due time, the Officer will directly contact the student with all relevant information and instructions on how to fill out the on-line UD form and what documents are to be provided before arrival:

- Copy of legal ID card or passport
- Copy of European Health Insurance Card (only for EU citizens) and/or private medical and accident insurance
- Home Institution's statement of the student's participation in the mobility to UD
- Proof/Certificate/Confirmation of Enrollment in the Home University for period of the mobility indicating: field, level and year of studies
- Passport-sized photograph with white background saved as jpg file named with student's name and surname
- If relevant, provisional Learning Agreement signed by student and Home University coordinators

Students have to ordinarily register for at least 30 ECTS credits per semester

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Otherwise no course for absolute beginners might be available for the regular course.

If the student is not ready to take courses in Spanish, please check our academic offer in English and make sure before they come that there are enough courses for them to take in order to avoid possible future problematic situations regarding this issue.

POSSIBILITY TO ATTEND COURSES FROM DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS
