Grading system

Please note that the grading system at Karlstad University was changed in January 2011. Karlstad University follows the recommendations of the European Union and does not issue ECTS grades. It is however possible for international students to print transcripts of records including the ECTS Grading Table (EGT), which presents the distribution of the national/local grades.

Important to know

Please note that our autumn semester ends in January. Some classes end before Christmas, but this is unfortunately nothing that we can guarantee for all exchange students. If students need to return home before Christmas, we advise them to get in contact with the course convenor in each specific case to make sure that an early departure is possible.

Student admission can only be guaranteed after the admissions officer has processed the applications. We try to welcome a balanced number of students over the Academic year. If you plan to send more students in one of the two semesters, we advise you to increase the number for the spring semester (rather than the autumn), because we usually have more places available in the spring semester.
