

SUMMER SCHOOLS 2019

Interview selection criteria

- Only full time degree students inscribed in the CULS UIS
- Study results min. 1 - 2
- English proficiency
- Good health condition
- Fulfilling the requirements of the summer school organisers
- Ability to pay for the return flight ticket to the summer school destination, health Insurance, eventually accommodation and meals
- Priority will be given to students did not participate in summer schools in the past years

Required documents

- ✓ Copy of latest Transcript of Records
- ✓ Filled out application form (download from web and send to coordinator)
- ✓ Certificate of English proficiency
- ✓ Motivation letter

Registering summer school participation as optional subject in UIS

Students who apply for a scholarship for attending a summer school (see below) **should spend 30 days at the summer school** in order to be registered in UIS (according to dates on the flight ticket). Before leaving, the student must fill out and submit at his/her Faculty study office: 1. application for outgoing mobility, 2. application for recognition of subject, 3. application for entering the subject in the UIS. The rectorate signs the approval of the applications

The applications should include the subject title and code:

BSc students: EHXB1Z Summer School Economy, Society and Nature Abroad

MSc students: EHYN1Z Summer School Economy, Society and Nature Abroad

PhD students: DHXD1Z Summer School Economy, Society and Nature Abroad

Scholarships

CULS awards scholarships to selected participants with one off scholarship, corresponding to the distance of the summer school destination. Students apply for a scholarship by filling out and signing a Declaration of Participant. The scholarship will be transferred to the account of the student before the start of the summer school.

Basic scholarship for participants in summer schools outside of the EU: 20 000 CZK

Basic scholarship for participants in summer schools in the EU: 10 000 CZK
