2. Courses

a. **Surabaya Historical Sites presented by Faculty of Social Science and Law:**

As the city of Heroes, Surabaya is packed with historical sites. This course discusses various historical sites in Surabaya and their significance in the past, present and future.

b. **Indonesian Dance and Music presented by Faculty of Languages & Art:**

The Indonesian Dance and Music course aims to provide the participants with opportunities to learn Indonesian Dance and Music from various Indonesian regions, where each dance and music has distinctive and unique styles.

c. **Disability in Indonesia presented by the Faculty of Education:**

This course will lead participants to navigate persons with disabilities' experience in Indonesian settings, from the history, policy, education, and socio-culture perspectives.

d. **Indonesian Traditional Games presented by Faculty of Sport Science:**

As an archipelagic country with various races and cultures, Indonesians enjoy different cultures and entertaining activities. This course discusses Indonesian Fun & Exciting Traditional Games played in the local communities, as well as its influence in the culture and local wisdom.

e. **Eco-campus presented by Faculty of Math and Natural Sciences:**

Eco Campus is an initiative in creating sustainable development in the campus environment by utilizing technology and science on campus. This course will discuss the efforts in establishing UNESA's Eco Campus program.

f. **Dolly, The Biggest Red Light District in Southeast Asia, Then and Now presented by Faculty of Economic:**

Dolly was once the biggest sex industry in Indonesia and South East Asia. Today, Dolly is one of the biggest centers of home industries in Surabaya. This course discusses the development of dolly in the past and how the Surabayan government was able to transform it into the center of economic hub today.

g. **Surabaya Culinary presented by Faculty of Engineering:**

One of the main reasons tourists visit Surabaya is to do a culinary tour as Surabayan food has one of the most favorite and unique dishes in Indonesia. This course discusses the various local Surabayan dishes along with its characteristics and uniqueness.
